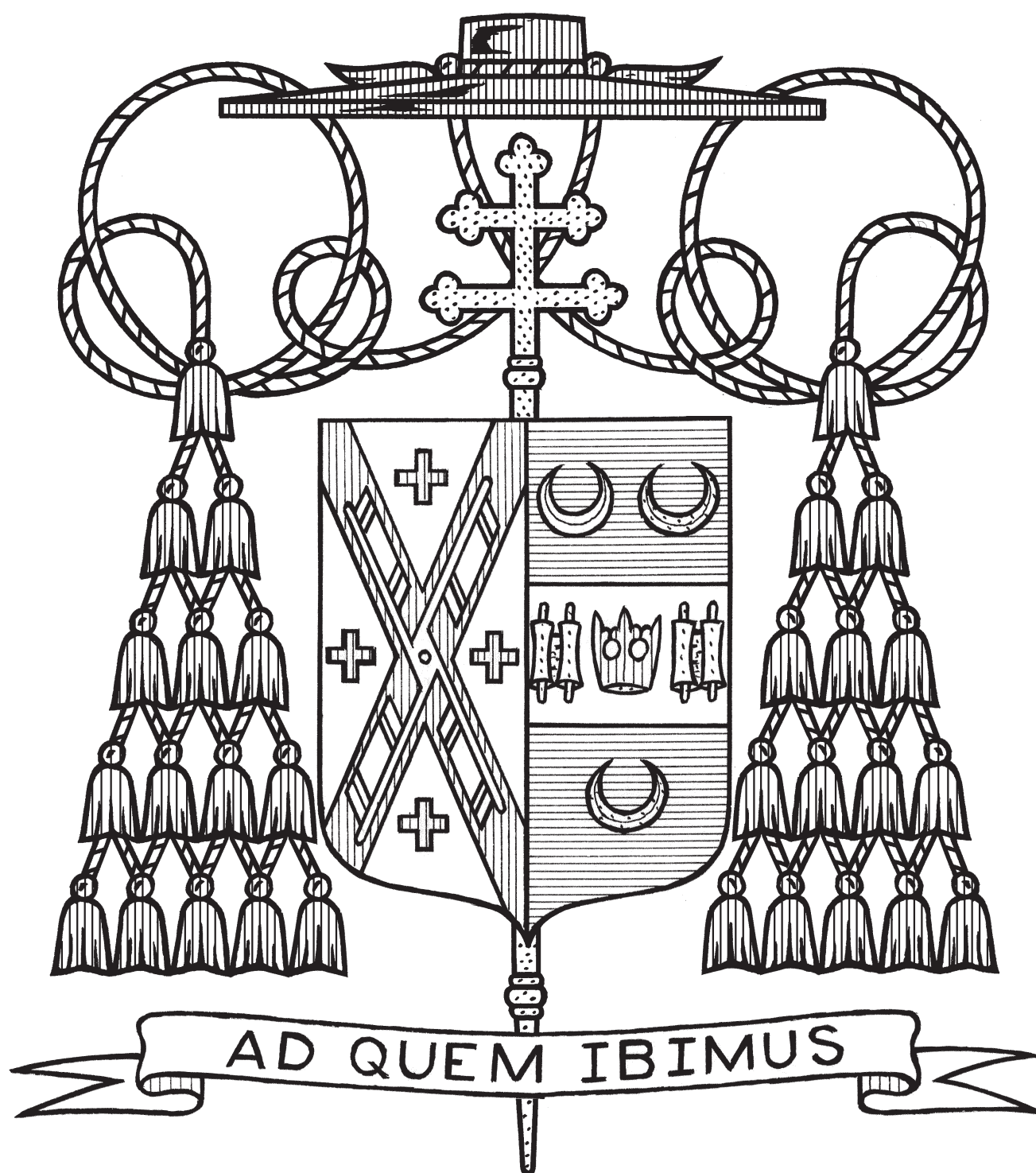

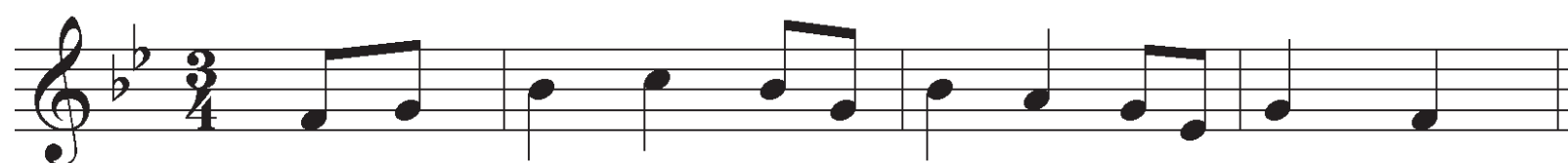
Brothers and sisters:
